

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS IAME Summer Cup 2019 21st June 2019



Ras Al Khaimah Kart Track, PO Box 2120, Ras Al Khaimah, UAE will organize IAME Summer Cup to create more fun racing for IAME UAE Karting Community. This race meeting for karts will be organized under permit number ATC/UAE – 2019 – TBC on Friday 21st of June 2019.

Entries open on publication. The Entry closing date is a week before the event.

The meeting will be held under the guidelines and spirit of the present International Sporting Code of the CIK/FIA, these and further Supplementary Regulations, the IAME Series 2018/2019 Sporting Regulations, IAME Series 2018/2019 Technical Regulations, IAME UAE Bambino Cup 2018/2019 Sporting & Technical Regulations and any further written instructions that the organizers may issue for the event.

Direction & length of Circuit: RAK Track - T-Shape - 876m - Clockwise.



The event is open to the following classes: Bambino, Mini, Junior, Senior, Master, Shifter

Subject to the number of entries being received the organizers could combine 2 or 3 categories to reach a minimum grid size of six per Class., Minimum inscription for each class to run is 6 entries.

Race Format: X30 classes: Qualifying, Pre-Final, Final

Bambino: Time Trial 1, Time Trial 2

Entry fee per round: X30 classes: AED 420 / Bambino: AED 210

ELIGIBLE COMPETITORS: All competitors must be holders of a current, valid and signed relevant Racing License applicable to the event, which will be examined at signing-on.

ENTRIES AND STARTERS: The organizers have the right to select or refuse entries. The maximum number of starters for each race will be that set by the organizers, subject to the limits set by the Track License and the Codes.

TRANSPONDERS: All entrants require their own TranX160 transponder. It will be mandatory for drivers to have completed their race entry, signed in, collected and installed their transponder on their kart prior to the warm up.

ENTRY DEFINITIONS: Admission to the public areas of the circuit will be free of charge.

ACCEPTANCE / REFUSAL OF ENTRIES: Entries should be received 7 Days before the race meeting date.

LATE ENTRIES: Entries received less than 7 days before the meeting are subject to late entry penalty. Entries on race day will not be accepted.

TYRES: New or used Komet tyres. Compound as per the IAME Series Technical Regulations.

TECHNICAL SCRUTINEERING: At Technical Bay. Obligatory for all drivers.

ENTRIES SUBMISSION: Faxed / emailed entries will be accepted but will only be fully valid once original forms are signed and entry fees paid.

No entries will be accepted on the day of the meeting. Any change of entry after this time will be subject to the approval of the Stewards of the Meeting.

RESULTS AND PROTESTS: Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after each race. Protests should be made in accordance with the Articles 8.1-8.6 of the present Code. Protest fee is fixed to AED 500, appeal fee is AED 1500.

RACING NUMBERS: As per the IAME Series 2018/2019 Sporting Regulations.

START POSITIONS: As per the IAME Series 2018/2019 Sporting Regulations.

SCRUTINEERING: All vehicles must comply with the IAME Series 2018/2019 Technical Regulations applicable for each particular category of the Championship. All vehicles entered in support races must comply with specific Sporting and Technical Rules of the class.

REGULATIONS: Flag signals will be given in accordance with the regulations of the Championship and with Appendix H of the Present Code.

DRIVER'S BRIEFING: Driver's briefing will be mandatory for all the drivers, they will need to sign the attendance sheet when coming in. Non-compliance will either result in exclusion or *AED 200* fine at the discretion of the stewards.

BULLETIN BOARD: The official notice board and bulletins will be located outside the Race Control room.

AWARDS: Medals for the top three winners of each class.
